University of Music Franz Liszt Weimar Special requirements for the audition/entrance exam

## Accordion - Bachelor of Music

The audition repertoire, consisting of approximately 20 minutes, should mainly consist of original literature for the accordion, using manual III (M III) at a middle level of difficulty. Applicants should also include a transcription or arrangement of a work from an earlier musical era.

- 1. Original literature from the 21st century (e.g. Hosokawa, Katzer, Schlünz)
- 2. Original literature from the 20<sup>th</sup> century (e.g. Jacobi, Kayser, Lundquist)
- 3. Transcription of a work from another musical era (e.g. Bach, Frescobaldi, Haydn)
- 4. Sight-reading
