### Lessons in the winter semester 2021/22

Only those persons may participate in classroom teaching who can provide proof of their status as "vaccinated", "recovered" or "tested" ("3G rule"). Persons who have recovered or have been vaccinated will receive a 2G certificate from the university on presentation of appropriate proof. Persons without a "2G certificate" are required to provide proof of a negative test, which must not be older than 72 hours. The university will make a supervised self-test available to all its members free of charge at two of its own test centres.
