**Application period BA and MA Musicology and BA Intercultural Music and Event Management: 15.02.-30.06.2022**

**Application period MA Arts Management: 15.02.-20.05.2022**

**Application period BA and MA Music Performance: 15.02.-15.03.2022**

For BA Musicology, qualification tests will no longer be conducted with the start of the current application round.

## APPLICATION

The following documents are to be attached to applications **for all the courses and subjects** of the Department of Musicology Weimar-Jena:

- The **application form** generated in the [online portal](#), or the corresponding form for students studying a core subject at FSU Jena
- Proof of **university entrance qualification**, or the semester qualification for years 11 to 12 available to date
- If necessary, a **transcript** for a previously completed undergraduate degree
- If necessary, a list of **previously completed assessments and examinations** (transcript of records), particularly in the case of a change of institution, or if the university certificate is not available at the time of application
- **CV** in tabular form
- **Letter of motivation**, stating the reasons for choosing the degree, professional ambitions etc. (applicants to the M.A. course in Musicology and the M.A. course in Arts Management must also explain which profile they would like to study and why)

- Overseas applications should enclose a **certificate** stating that they are proficient in German (TestDaf 4 or DSH 2), as well as an officially certified translation of all other (official) documents
- Applicants from the People's Republic of China should enclose their **original certificate** from the Akademische Prüfungsstelle Peking (APS)
