Trombone (Jazz) – BACHELOR Special Requirements for the Audition

There will be systems set up at the audition for those applicants who will be performing "playalong" literature. The ability of the applicant to improvise will be tested in all areas, including in ensemble work. Accompanists will be available for those applicants who may be presenting a classical work. Music/scores for the pieces must be submitted at least 14 days before the audition.

- Performance of a classical or subject-specific work, or a solo transcription
- Performance of 3 stylistically different jazz songs, at least one of which should be a ballad (i.e. from the "Real Book", Aebersold, etc.) in the order: Theme- original improvisationtheme, with emphasis on the improvisation.
- Sight-reading of a easy to mid difficulty piece selected by the audition committee (i.e. etude, big band part)
- Sight-reading of chord changes, as well as rhythmic and melodic ear training on the instrument
