## Guitar - Bachelor of Music

Multi-stage procedure

1st step	<b>video selection</b>
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### Video requirements:

At the closing date for applications, the recording should not be older than one year.

The duration of the video is approximately 5 minutes including a personal introduction.

All works will be played in a link one after the other without editing.

The camera distance is max. 3 metres, applicants are to be seen in full, including hands and feet. The technical quality of the video recording does not have to be professional.

### Performance of the following works:

F.Tarrega 1 Prelude AND an Etude by F.Sor from op.31, op.6 or op.29

OR a Caprice from 36 Capricci by L.Legnani

2nd step	<b>attendance exam (invitation after passing the 1st step)</b>
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1. a memorised performance of several pieces from three different periods, according to the candidate's level of performance - with the degree of difficulty of the following sample complexes:
  - Spanish vihuela works (Milán, Narváez, Mudarra and others)
  - J. Dowland - a fantasy or comparable lute works
  - G. A. Brescianello, F. Corbetta, R. de Visée, G. Sanz, F. Guerau, S.L. Weiss
  - J. S. Bach - from the works for lute, violin, cello
  - J. K. Mertz, bard sounds
  - Barrios
  - H. Villa-Lobos, Préludes, Suite Populaire Brésilienne
  - Mrs Tarrega
  - S. Müller, improvisation and toccata
  - F. Just, agitation
  - M. de Falla, Homenaje
  - M. Castelnuovo-Tedesco
  - Leo Brouwer
  - H. W. Henze, Tentos
