Applicants to the Master program are expected to select pieces appropriate for a final exam for a Diploma or Bachelor of Music degree in the same area. Applicants will be required to present a program of approximately 50–60 minutes to the audition committee. The selection of works to be performed will be assessed as part of the audition process.
