Initial contact and counseling principles

In nearly all counseling centers, a phone call is the easiest way to make initial contact. In most cases, you will then make an appointment for a face-to-face meeting or a detailed phone call. Sometimes a video call is the best solution. If it is urgent, you will usually get an appointment immediately. Otherwise, depending on the offer, there may be waiting periods of several weeks (mostly due to staff shortages.) It is therefore recommended making contact with the counseling center early on.

Many counseling centers also offer open consultation hours where you can have an initial face-to-face meeting without having to register. You can also contact them by email or using the online form, in which you can describe your situation and your concerns in a few sentences.

Ethical principles of counseling: Confidentiality, anonymity, partiality, independence

All services on this list are free of charge and subdue to the principles of confidentiality and anonymity: Counselors are obliged to keep your concerns to themselves or to a previously defined, narrow group of people who have been made transparent to you. Depending on the form of counseling and the sensitivity of the topic, you will remain completely anonymous (especially regarding supra-regional telephone counseling services) or you may only disclose your telephone number or e-mail address (telephone counseling, online counseling). Counseling centers for cases of discrimination, violence, crime and conflict also work according to the principle of partiality: they take your experiences seriously, take your side and support you in the best possible way. Another important criterion is the independence of a counseling service. All professional advice centers are free from political influence and independent from government institutions.

The special situation of internal universitarian contact points

For counseling services within the university, meeting the requirements of independence on sensitive topics such as discrimination or bullying can be an almost impossible act of balancing: The foremost relevant contact persons (students and teaching staff) are often in a personal or professional relationship with the perpetrators of boundary violations, especially at a small university. For example, a member of the Awareness Working Group may take part in the same musical ensemble as a student who behaves in a way that violates the boundaries of others. Another scenario might be: a member of the committee for diversity may work on a panel with a teacher who has been alleged of discriminating against a student. Due to these resulting role conflicts, external bodies are a more suitable first point of contact. It may be wise to use the university's services in a second step, as they know the structures and possibilities for internal processing and the formal ways of communication for filing a complaint.

When students act as a contact point (peer-to-peer counseling), they have the advantage of being able to understand the situation of their fellow student within the social structure of the university and can therefore offer emotional support.

Language: Almost every counseling service in this list offers counseling in *English*. Confirmed english-speaking consulting points are being labelled as such with the letter (*E*). In addition, many counseling offers have access to a simultaneous telephone interpreter service in dozens of languages.
