

Good to know

As a KEX student, you are at home in your department (institute).

You will receive 2 hours of tuition of your main subject per week per semester. In addition, you will have to plan and perform three concerts independently during the first three semesters. You must provide proof of these to register for the KEX examination.

In addition to the concerts, the artistic and organizational preparation for the two parts of the KEX examination will take up a large part of your studies.

KEX examination program

Please determine the examination program for the KEX together with your main subject teacher.

Scheduling and room bookings

Examinations take place on the premises of the university and only in exceptional cases externally. Please look for an available date early at **hfm-weimar.asimut.net** and reserve it with Nicolae Vezure.

Preference for taking a KEX Examination with (University) Orchestra

If you wish to take a preliminary examination with an orchestra, you are responsible for composing this orchestra. Please note that there is no automatic right to play any examination element with an orchestra.

Unfortunately, only a few students are able to perform with the University Orchestra (HSO), as the programme is planned far ahead, in accordance with the teaching content of the HSO. Since the successful passing of the 1st part of the KEX examination number 1 is a prerequisite for being allowed to play with the HSO, it is not possible to play the 2nd part of the KEX examination with the University Orchestra (HSO) within the standard period of study. You do not need to register your interest in playing with the HSO - the head of the HSO will approach you if you are being considered. Your right to take the exam remains valid for 3 years after you leave the university. If you have not received an invitation to play with the HSO 1.5 years before the end of your right to an examination, please organise an examination without the HSO.

Exam registration

Please note that the examination preparation must be completed before you can register your KEX at the examination office. For an examination in the following summer semester, please submit your documents by 31.01. or, for an examination in the following winter semester, by 30.06.

Both parts of the exam can be taken together in one semester or individually. You can register them individually or simultaneously.

Examinations can be taken up to 3 years after exmatriculation.

Examination board

Both parts of the KEX examination are taken before an *interdisciplinary* examination board.

Presentation

You are not prohibited from presenting during your exam. You are welcome to comment on the repertoire.

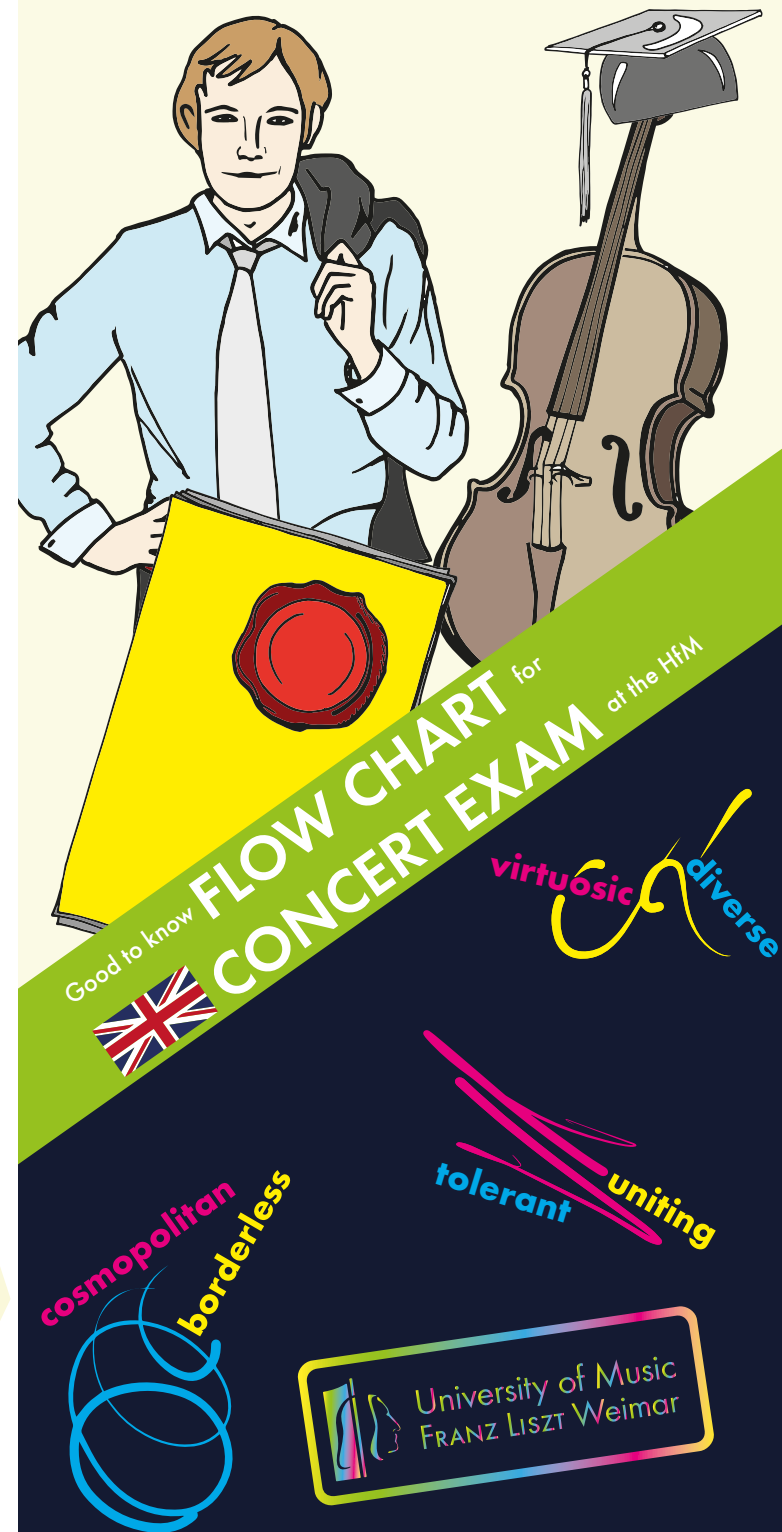
