



Call for nominations DAAD Prize 2025

The DAAD Prize is awarded annually to a student personality at the HfM Weimar who has outstanding artistic or academic qualifications and outstanding intercultural commitment. The prize is awarded during the enrolment ceremony.

What is awarded?

Outstanding artistic or academic achievements

and

Outstanding social and intercultural commitment to the university community

Who can be nominated?

Foreign students who are enrolled at the HfM Weimar in order to obtain a degree and

 who are at an advanced stage of their Bachelor's degree programme (at least 4th semester) or Master's degree programme at the time of the call for nominations

or

 a graduate, provided that the examination was not more than approx. 3 months ago at the time of the nomination deadline

or

are at the beginning of their concert examination studies or doctoral studies (not more than 6 months
after admission) at the time of the nomination deadline and have previously studied at the HfM
Weimar and obtained a degree.

Who can nominate?

All teachers at the University of Music FRANZ LISZT Weimar.

The following documents must be attached to the nomination:

- Letter of motivation
- Curriculum vitae (preferably using the <u>Europass template</u>) with details of your artistic and/or academic career as well as information on special achievements as defined in the call
- Assessment by the main subject lecturer or supervising lecturer, as well as the formal support of the head of the institute (by signing the assessment report, see form)

Important notes

- 1. this is not a research award
- 2. students who already receive a DAAD scholarship cannot be considered
- 3. students must not be German nationals (even additionally) and are aiming for a degree at the university.
